**MotoCzys Chosen as the People's Choice Winner of
Oregon Entrepreneurs Network's Venture Northwest 2011**
Ralph Shaw presented with the OEN Silicon Forest Pioneer Award

PORTLAND, Ore. – November 3, 2011 — The Oregon Entrepreneurs Network (OEN) today announced that MotoCzys was honored with the people's choice award at the annual OEN's Venture Northwest 2011 conference. MotoCzys was recognized as a leading innovator out of the ten companies featured at OEN's Venture Northwest 2011 conference held at the Governor Hotel in Portland that was attended by leading venture capitalists from the country.

At the event OEN also honored Northwest entrepreneur Ralph Shaw with a special award-- the Silicon Forest Pioneer Award, in recognition of his critical role in the early days of funding companies in the Silicon Forest. Shaw has had an extensive impact on entrepreneurship and job creation in the Northwest as an entrepreneur, business leader and venture capitalist. In 1980 Shaw became the founder and President of Shaw Management Company, located in Portland, Oregon. In 1983 together with U.S. Bancorp Shaw formed Shaw Venture Partners, which funded and guided startups such as Costco, Integra Telecom, Actel Corp., Telestream, Dendreon, and Sequent Computer Systems.

OEN's Venture Northwest People's Choice Winner

MotoCzys was selected from among ten companies chosen to present at OEN's Venture Northwest 2011 including Meridian, The Clymb, Pacific Light Technologies, Cloudability, Avado, 4-Tell, , OpenSesame, Night & Day Studios, and Northwest Analytics.

MotoCzys created the D1g1tal Dr1ve, fully integrated drive solution. It is a critical building block for the emerging electronic Vehicle (EV) sector. The solution consists of a motor, controller, differential, gear reduction and cooling system. It will allow EV manufacturers to build more EVs in a shorter time frame and for less money.

"The companies presenting at this year's event demonstrated creative innovation and determination that are needed to stimulate the Northwest's entrepreneurial sector and build the industries of tomorrow." said Steve Eichenlaub, chair of OEN's Venture Northwest and a Managing Director of Strategic Investments at Intel Capital.

Since 1996, OEN's Venture Northwest presenting companies have raised over \$1.5B in venture capital and over \$68 million in angel investments. This is about \$100M per year, about \$10M per presenting company, consistently over the last 15 years.
