A BRIEF HISTORY



WHY HAVE AN ANGEL FOOD CONFERENCE?

- Oregon is an innovator in food and beverage
- Funding any early stage company is hard; funding food and beverage companies is even harder
- Focusing on one sector allows us to provide mentorship and education in a way we could not in the past
- Convening community: F&B companies at all stages, mentors, investors, service providers, industry expert like co-packers, distributors, kitchens, etc.



WHAT IS THE ANGEL FOOD CONFERENCE?

- A four-part, three-month educational program
- A one-day angel conference with investors, industry experts, "Pitch Fest", and Food Fair
- A major event to provide visibility to the industry
- An opportunity to pitch at the May PubTalk
- An opportunity to win pro bono professional services (Concept stage)
- An opportunity for later-stage companies to win an investment of approximately \$100K



WHO SHOULD PARTICIPATE?

Any entrepreneur – from concept to growth stage – who wants to expand their food & beverage company. There are different ways to engage depending on your stage.

- Present to 200+ investors and business leaders at OEN's Angel Food Fair
- Win a prize package of goods and services worth up to \$20K
- Learn from experts & successful entrepreneurs at four educational sessions



HOW DO I KNOW IF I AM ELIGIBLE?

Companies participating in the concept stage competition typically:

- Have a great idea, and are close to "proof of concept"
- Are in the process of testing their product in the market
- Have little if any revenue yet



HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The cost to apply to the Angel Food Conference 2019 Concept Stage Competition is:

- \$99 for OEN members
- \$190 for non-OEN members



WHAT DOES THE APPLICATION FEE INCLUDE?

- Admission to the Angel Food Conference on June 19 (\$125 value)
- Coaching & mentoring from business leaders (priceless!)
- Top-notch education from experts at four educational sessions (\$200+ value)

STARTUP / DEVELOPING STAGE CATEGORY



WHY SHOULD I PARTICIPATE?

Ready to scale? Apply to OEN's Angel Food Startup Developing Stage

Competition for an opportunity to:

- Hone your pitch and business plan
- Get coaching & mentoring from business leaders
- Learn from experts at four educational sessions
- Present to 200+ investors and business leaders at OEN's Angel Food Conference
- A chance to win a \$100K+ investment (actual investment will depend on the number of investors)



HOW DO I KNOW IF I AM ELIGIBLE?

Companies participating in the Startup / Developing Stage Competition typically:

- Have a proven concept and a complete business plan developed
- Have a product and are selling it "somewhere" (farmer's markets, local stores, national chains, etc.)
- Have generated initial revenues of up to \$250K (Startup Stage) or up to about \$2mm (Developing Stage) and are ready for market expansion
- Non-consumer products companies like restaurants are eligible to go through the program but are not eligible to compete for the investment



HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The cost to apply to the Angel Food Conference 2019 Startup / Developing Stage Competition is \$250 for OEN members. The cost for non-members depends on your stage:

- For Startup Stage companies (those with revenues of up to \$250K), the cost is \$385, which includes one year of OEN Startup Stage Membership (a \$50 discount)
- For Developing Stage companies (those with revenues of \$250K \$2mm), the cost is \$500 (a \$145 discount)



WHAT DOES THE APPLICATION FEE INCLUDE?

- Admission to the Angel Food Conference on June 19 (\$125 value)
- Coaching & mentoring from business leaders (priceless!)
- Learning from experts at four educational sessions (\$200+ value)
- Begin the due diligence process for a chance to land a \$100K+ investment
- A table at the Food Fair (\$100 value)
- The opportunity to apply for loans of up to \$250,000 through Business Oregon's Small Business Expansion Program
